Evaluation Methods Used: Tested KITABOO Online reader involved reviewing representative pages from fixed layout eBook, audio files using Windows 11, Chrome, Firefox, Edge; NVDA; Windows 11, Chrome, Firefox, Edge; JAWS; and Colour Contrast Analyzer as well as exclusive use of the keyboard and also tested on MAC Safari Voice Over, iOS Safari Voice Over, iPad Safari Voice Over, Android Phone Chrome Talkback, Android Tab Chrome Talkback.
